He still missed his family, but he realized that this was what he needed to do to grow as a person.

John has now graduated from high school with excellent grades and is preparing to go to university - this time in a completely different country. He is not nervous, though, because he has already experienced living away from home. He knows he can do it, and he is sure that his family will always be there for him.
